Primary School Applications September 2021

If you have a child that turns 4 years old this academic year, (1" September 2020 to 31" August 2021), then now is the time to apply for Reception class starting in September 2021. The application form can be found on the Council website and you have until the 15th January 2021 to submit the form.

School Streets!

Can I remind everyone that Elsham Road, Worsley Road and part of Cary Road are School Streets. They are closed to all cars, vans etc between the times of 8.30am and 9.30am and again between 3pm and 4pm.

The only exception to this is if you live in these roads or have registered for a School Streets permit because you either work at the school or you hold a disability parking badge and have registered your car.

Adults and Children should be aware that cars can still drive down these roads with the appropriate permits at any time so everyone should still be very aware of road safety.
