If your child usually has packed lunch and would like a Christmas Dinner on that day it will cost £2.30 and should be paid on Parentpay. If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 then you are entitled to Universal Free School meals and therefore there is no cost. Similarly if you are entitled to Free School Meals in Key Stage 2 then you do not have to pay.

Change of Start and End Times From Monday 30th November

We are changing our start and end times slightly for some classes as the children are brilliant at coming into school and leaving quickly and safely. Moving Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 by 5 minutes closer to the other start times will mean that siblings that go home early do not miss out on so much learning.
