- Begin to understand such abstract terms as 'empire', 'civilisation', and 'parliament'.
- Create a timeline showing all the rulers from 1066 till the present day on shields to display in class.

Maths

Mathematical Development

Please see below for a week by week overview of the maths areas that we will be covering this half term:

<u>Week 1</u>– **Place Value**—Comparing and ordering 4-digit numbers

<u>Week 2</u>– **Fractions**—Dividing numbers by 10 and 100

<u>Week 3</u> - **Fractions**—Count up and down in hundredths.

<u>Week 4</u> - **Measures**—Converting between different units of measure

<u>Week 5</u> - **Geometry, Position and Direction**—Grid co-ordinates.

<u>Week 6</u>– **Fractions**—Recognising decimal equivalents of tenths and hundredths.

English

Our literacy lessons this half-term will focus on the text Varjak Paw by SF Said.



We started reading this story last half-term and the children are really enjoying it. On Tuesday 27th April we will be having a live Q&A session with the author.

We will continue to have daily reading lessons in which we will be focusing on different reading skills.

We also have a dedicated Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling lesson each week.

Science

Our Science topic for this half-term is Electricity. The children will investigate which materials conduct electricity, how switches work and how to make simple circuits.

History

Our topic this half term is called Reign Over Us. In these lessons we will be learning about and understanding the history of Britain in chronological order from 1066 to the present day. The children will be learning about notable British rulers, considering how their lives have influenced our history and the wider world.

Art/DT

Over the next few weeks we will be working on a design project investigating biomimicry. The children will be learning about how inventors have been inspired by nature and will be coming up with their own ideas for inventions based on the natural world.
